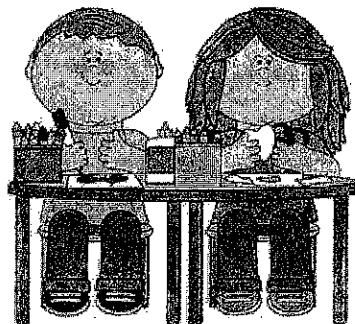

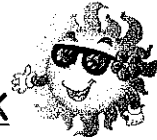

**Reading:** Continue to practice reading on Raz-Kids (second grade uses the program also) Check out the library!

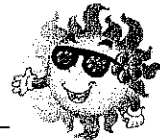
**Writing:** Use the summer journal and prompts to write AT LEAST TWICE A WEEK in your journal. (Second grade teacher will be asking for these journals next school year)
